Thema/Theme: Cylch, Cylchoedd a Phopeth Crwn
Circles, Rings and All Things Round

Agored i bob Ffederasiwn Sefydliad y Merched - un ymgais i bob Ffederasiwn.
Open to all Federations of Women's Institutes - one entry per federation.

Arddangosiad i'w lwyfannu ar furdd trestl. Y gofod a ganiateir - 2'6" (76cm) o led a 2'3" (68cm) o ddyfnder. Dim terfyn uchaf - ni chaniateir defnyddio unrhyw gefndir ychwanegol.
Exhibit to be staged on a trestle table. Space allowed - 2'6" (76cm) wide by 2ft 3" (68cm) deep. Height unlimited - no additional backing allowed.

Rhaid trefnu'r arddangosiad yn y Sioe o fewn y gofod a roddwyd. Enw'r cystadleuydd a'r Ffederasiwn i'w harddangos.

Exhibits must be arranged at the show within the space allocated. Name of competitor and Federation to be displayed.

Cewch gwario hyd at £50 ar flodau (ddim yn cynnwys dail) ac bydd angen i gystadleuwyr darparu derbynneb yn y digwyddiad.

A maximum spend of £50 on flowers is allowed (not including foliage) and members will be required to provide a receipt at the event.

Beirnedir yr arddangosiad yn ôl "Schedule of Definitions" cyhoeddiad NAFAS i Gystadleuaeth
The exhibit will be judged in accordance with the current edition of "Schedule of Definitions" NAFAS Competition Manual.

Mae penderfyniad y beirniad yn derfynol.
The judges' decision is final.

Nodyn - cyfansoddiad arddangosiad yw deunydd planhigion naturiol gydag ychwanegiadau neu hebddynt, o fewn y gofod a nodir yn y rheolau.

Note - an exhibit is composed of natural plant material, with or without accessories, contained within the space as specified in the schedule.

The following rules as outlined in the schedule apply to the above competition

- 1. No exhibit to be taken away before 5.00pm on Thursday 23 July**
- 2. During staging times in the Flower Arrangement Section exhibitors and officials only may remain in that part of the Marquee**
- 3. All entries to be arranged in the marquee and must be the unaided work of the competitor**
- 4. No responsibility will be accepted by the Royal Welsh Agricultural Society for loss or damage to exhibits (or any portion thereof) or personal belongings before, during or after the exhibition, nor will the Society be responsible for the loss of any plant, flower or receptacle in transit to or from or on the Showground.**
