**Day 1 Two** unusual and transforming techniques which are a lot of fun with amazing results!!! One using scrapes of all kinds of material to produce a beautiful piece of finished fabric and a new needle case!!!! The second technique is especially good for changing an unloved fabric into a beautiful textured material ideal for making cushions, bags etc.

No needles, thread or sewing machines are needed for this day. I will provide Bondaweb and irons and ironing boards.

Day 2 Making a beautiful scarf with left over yarns threads and lace by layer them with two soluble fabrics and basic stitching with a sewing machine. Also it may be possible if time, to do a few small samples with various fabrics, sheer nylons for instance that I would provide. I will bring various fabrics and lots of my work and samples to show.

Willow Weaving – Helen Munday – 8 spaces. £355.00 plus £10.00 materials payable to Tutor.

Helen is an Artist Basket Maker creating contemporary and traditional basketry.

Much of the willow she uses is home grown from cuttings she specially selected for its basket making qualities. Day 1 learn to make a basket with coloured willow and day two a bird feeder.
