31 January 2026 at the Village Hotel Swansea – Genealogy OR Willow Weaving

West – Swansea Venue – WI Members whose meeting hall has a SA postcode plus CF31, CF32, CF33, CF34 and CF35.

East – Cardiff Venue – WI Members whose meeting hall has a CF postcode excepting those listed above.

We are attempting to ensure roughly equal access across the Federation. The division above ensures individuals, have an hour or less travel to the venue. This is a trial for us, and we will see how it works. As with anything it is not perfect, but we will only find out by doing this.
