"Long & Winding Road"

CLASS 1 Story

A story entitled "Long & Winding Road". Maximum 500 words. To be submitted with your entry form either by email or post no later than the closing date Friday 12th June 2026.

"Yesterday"

CLASS 2 Poem

A poem entitled "Yesterday". To be submitted with your entry form either by email or post no later than the closing date Friday 12th June 2026.

"Name That Tune"

CLASS 3 Co-operative

A song of your choice, your interpretation should reveal the song. To include one floral exhibit; two craft items; one cooked item; one preserve (this can be a cordial). Staging and presentation to be judged. To be displayed on a board. Maximum table space allowed 22"/56cm deep x 29.5"/75cm wide height unlimited. No more than two members to stage at the show. Must be the work of at least three members. Do not display the song title!

"Sausage Rolls for Everyone"

CLASS 4 Cookery

Three sausage rolls using your own short crust pastry. Any filling e.g. meat, vegetarian, vegan but using homemade short crust pastry only. Size 5-6cm/2"-2½". Three to be entered for judging. Please provide your recipe ingredients (but not method).

"Food Glorious Food"

CLASS 5 Cookery

Savoury scones – three to be entered for judging. Please provide the recipe for display.

"Victoria"

CLASS 6 Cookery

Victoria jam sandwich not to exceed 8"/20cms in diameter.

"Strawberry Fields Forever"

CLASS 7 Preserve

A jar of strawberry jam. One entry per member.

"Sugar, Sugar"

CLASS 8 Sugar Craft

Any item of sugar craft. Maximum size 8"/20cm x 8"/20cm. Height unlimited.

"There's No One Quite Like Grandma"

CLASS 9 Craft

Any crocheted item made from Granny Squares. Maximum size 20"/50cms x 20"/50cms.

"Needles & Pins"

CLASS 10 Craft

A quilted item no larger than 30"/76cm x 30"/76cm.

"Lady in Red"

CLASS 11 Craft

An item of craft using predominantly shades of red.Any craft; any medium.No cards.

"We Will Rock You"

CLASS 12 Craft

A decorated pebble or stone, any medium. Please note it is illegal and damaging to the environment to remove pebbles from a beach. Please obtain from a responsible source.

"Baby Love"

CLASS 13 Craft

A <u>knitted</u> item for a baby (0-12 months). No shawls or blankets. Please indicate on your entry if you wish your item to be donated to a Baby Bank after the show. Further details in the show programme.

"Anything Goes"

CLASS 14 Craft

This is a novice class for members who have not won any prize in the Glamorgan Show since 2020. Any item of craft but no cards.

"Sparkle"

CLASS 15 Craft

Any item of jewellery, any medium. Please note a pair of earrings is classed as one item.

"Circle of Life"

CLASS 16 - Craft

A front door wreath – any season or occasion, any medium.

CLASS 17 – Craft

"Happy Birthday To You"

A birthday card and envelope.

"Love Grows"

CLASS 18 Co-operative

A basket or trug of 6 different items of home-grown fruit and/or vegetables. Presentation and items to be judged. Must be the work of at least two members.

"You Don't Bring Me Flowers"

CLASS 19

Three homegrown specimen flowers of the same variety. To be brought to the show in a vase. No valuable or fragile vases please. No other materials or oasis to be included. A photograph of the flowers on the plant to be included and a label saying variety.

"My Way"

CLASS 20 Floral

An imposed floral class. All components will be provided. Only your own scissors/secateurs may be brought to the staging area on Friday 10th July. Exhibitors may use all or some of the components provided. No components other than those supplied should be incorporated. All exhibitors must commence at the time specified in the schedule and notify the Show Committee if you are unable to attend.

"Summer Holiday"

CLASS 21 Floral

A novice class for members who have not won any prize in any floral class at the Glamorgan Show since 2020. A floral exhibit depicting a summer holiday. Additional material including fresh, dried, preserved or artificial may be used. Space allowed 18"/46cm deep, 18"/46cm wide, height unlimited. To be viewed and judged from the front. To be brought ready assembled.

"Twist & Shout"

CLASS 22 Floral

A floral exhibit incorporating a CD disc. Fresh, dried, preserved or artificial plant material may be incorporated. Maximum size 12"/30cm x 12"/30cm. Height unlimited. To be viewed and judged from the front. To be brought ready assembled.

"Dock of the Bay"

CLASS 23 Photography

A photograph of a bay, dock or marina. 5" x 7" maximum. No frames. No mount.

"Sunrise, Sunset"

CLASS 24 Art

A sunrise or sunset scene. Any medium e.g. watercolour, sketch.oil, gouache, pastel. A3 maximum. No frames.

"Our House"

CLASS 25 Men's/Partner's Class

A house sign or number, any medium.
